TECHNICAL BULLETIN PREVENTATIVE MAINTENACE REQUIRED

SUBJECT: RETIRING CAM BOTTOM ASSEMBLY

EQUIPMENT: PEELLE 233010 RETIRING CAM BOTTOM ASSEMBLY

DESCRIPTION: PEELLE HAS DISCOVERED THAT SOME 233010 RETIRING CAM BOTTOM AS-

SEMBLIES ARE NOT FULLY EXTENDING OR RETIRING AS DESIGNED. THIS IS DUE TO THE HOLES ON THE CAM FACE ASSEMBLY BEING OUT OF ALIGNMENT WITH THE HOLES IN THE LINKAGE ARMS. THIS PROBLEM IS VISIBLE WHEN THE CAM FACE IS VERY SLOW MOVING OR STRUGGLES TO FINAL

RETIRED/EXTENDED POSITION.

ACTION: REMOVE THE E-RINGS AND PIVOT PINS THAT CONNECT THE LINKAGE

ARMS TO THE CAM FACE ASSEMBLY. USE A 25/64" [10mm] DRILL TO REAM

THE CAM FACE ASSEMBLY.
